One Session Side-Game Pairs are available during all sessions where bridge is shown. All 2-session pair events are stratflighted by average (Open ABC and Gold Rush DEF.) Open Pair Games: A=Unlimited, B=1250, C=0-1250. Gold Rush Pairs: D=300-750, E=100-300, F=0-100. Gold Rush Swiss (0-750) and Open Swiss Teams are also stratflighted by average within each field. All bridge games play 18 deals.

OCT. 12 – Depart Los Angeles (6PM)

OCT. 13 – Ensenada, Mexico (8AM–4PM). Ensenada is a sportsman's paradise for surfing, sport fishing, kayaking, horseback riding and mountain biking. Take a scenic drive to the Punta Banda Peninsula to La Bufadora, one of the largest blow-holes in North America.

OCT. 15 – Cabo San Lucas, Mexico (10AM–8PM). Once a fishing village visited by surfers and sport fishermen, it has now become the focal point of Los Cabos, the catch-all term for the beaches and resorts ringing the toe of the peninsula.

OCT. 16 – La Paz, Mexico (7AM–4PM). Nestled among laurels and date palms on the Sea of Cortez, La Paz offers tranquil beaches, beautiful bays, and stunning off-shore islands.

OCT. 17 – Mazatlán, Mexico (8AM–4PM). Mazatlán boasts long stretches of palm-lined beaches. In Old Mazatlán, visit the Cathedral of the Immaculate Concep-

tion, crowned with a gold ceiling, and then stroll through the colonial-era Plaza Republica with its charming Victorian bandstand. Witness the daring cliff divers!

OCT. 18 – Manzanillo, Mexico (11AM–7PM). Verdant tropical environment lies along two crescent-shaped bays separated by the scenic outcrop of the Santiago Peninsula. You may wish to take in the fabulous vistas as you play a round of golf on one of the areas lush courses.

OCT. 19 – Puerto Vallarta, Mexico (7AM–4PM). International style and old-world charm are tucked within the sparkling Banderas Bay and embraced by the majestic Sierra Madre Mountains. Stroll the cobblestone streets looking for fine silver jewelry, designer clothing, leather goods and handmade pottery.
