March 3: Embark Miami, FL.

March 4: Nassau, Bahamas. Find yourself in the middle of the vibrant Junkanoo culture, bustling straw markets, and glitzy casinos. You'll be surrounded by swaying palms, white-sand beaches and the crystal-clear waters that make the islands of the Bahamas famous. March 5: at sea.
